Description

SHEETROCK® TOTAL LITE™ (Total Lite) finishing compound is a lightweight premium grade product which offers all the benefits of conventional-weight compound but is up to 25% lighter and results in less shrinkage and is easy to sand. It makes handling and applying simpler, easier and faster. It is designed to be used in conjunction with BaseCote™ and RediBase™ compounds.

Advantages

Recommended

- Total Lite is suitable for the final coating of plasterboard joints, angles, and fastener heads when used in conjunction with BaseCote or RediBase compounds.
- Total Lite is suitable for use as the second and third coat in the Knauf three coat jointing system.
- Total Lite can be used over plasterboard or fibre cement sheeting.

Installation

Application

- Surfaces must be clean a free of dust.
- Total Lite can be diluted with water for use in mechanical tools as necessary. Add water in 250ml increments to avoid over thinning.
- Can be applied with hand or mechanical tools.
- Only apply over base compounds that have been allowed to dry thoroughly (24hrs).
- Total Lite compound must be allowed to dry thoroughly (approx. 24 hours) before sanding or coating.
- If needed, sand lightly with 220 grit sandpaper.
- Thoroughly clean all tools and equipment after use.

Avoid

- The application of Total Lite compound at interior temperatures less than 13°C is not recommended; under cold or wet weather conditions, allow more than 24 hours for thorough drying.
- When diluting Total Lite do not vigorously over mix as this will introduce entrapped air which can result in surface imperfections.
- Do not apply Total Lite over joints that are not thoroughly dry. Pinholes may result.
- Do not use sandpaper lower than 180 grit; take care to avoid scratching when sanding.
- The inclusion of other materials to a mix will impair the performance (e.g. reduced strength and poor adhesion) and void the product warranty.

Mixing

- Always use clean tools.
- Do not mix with residues of previously used compounds; the inclusion of such materials will impair the performance of this product and will void the product warranty.
- Total Lite may not require thinning. However, if needed, lightly mix and test its application. If required, add water carefully to achieve desired consistency.
- Caution: Avoid over-thinning when adding water as this may cause cracking and excessive shrinkage.
- If liquid has separated from the compound, stir carefully to restore consistency.
- Caution: Do not overmix; overmixing can introduce air bubbles, which can create surface imperfections.

Storage

- Total Lite should be stored under cover in a dry environment and protected from temperature extremes; storage in an unsuitable environment can shorten the life of this product.
- Protect product from freezing, direct sunlight and extreme heat.
- Total Lite has a shelf life of up to 12 months under good storage conditions.

Health & Safety

- Dust from this product contains Silica. Prolonged inhalation may be harmful to health.
- Ensure adequate ventilation. Wear eye protection and an approved disposable respirator which conforms to AS1716: 2012 Type P1 or P2.
- If dust or paste causes irritation use impervious PVC, nitrile or rubber gloves. Wash exposed skin after handling. If product gets into the eyes, wash thoroughly with clean water.
- Do not ingest contents of package. If ingested, seek medical advice immediately.
- 5. Keep contents out of reach of children.
- Be conscious of the environment. Dispose of empty packaging in a responsible manner.
- 7. Follow safe lifting instructions on the product label.
